

Non-Chord Tones

(AKA Nonharmonic tones or Embellishing Tones)

NCT	Name	Approach	Resolution	Direction
PT	Passing Tone	Step (Between different notes)	Step	Same
NT	Neighboring Tone	Step (Between the same note)	Step	Opposite
ET	Escape Tone	Step	Leap	Opposite (usually)
APP	Appoggiatura	Leap	Step	Opposite (usually)
NG	Neighbor Group (Two notes)	Step and Leap (a 2 nd then a 3 rd)	Step	Opposite
SUS	Suspension (4-3) (9-8) (7-6) (2-3)	Retain (Repeat note)	Step	Down
RET	Retardation	Retain (Repeat note)	Step	Up
ANT	Anticipation	Step	Retain (Repeat note)	Up or Down

Definitions: Non-Chord Tone: A note that is not a member of the chord identified

Step: Major or minor 2nd in either direction

Leap: A skip of a 3rd or larger

Retain: Repeat or hold a note in the same voice
